Job Description

POSITION: Law Clerk – Summer 2026 (hybrid)

AGENCY DESCRIPTION: Asian Law Alliance, established in 1977, is a non-profit organization providing equal access to the justice system for Asian Pacific Islander and low-income populations in the Silicon Valley. Our mission is through providing legal counseling, community education and community organizing, we promote self-sufficiency, self-reliance, and a better quality of life for all. Our priority areas are immigration, housing, domestic violence, public benefits and civil rights.

POSITION DESCRIPTION: Law clerks will have the opportunity to participate in various aspects of ALA services, including initial client contact, fact investigation, legal research and writing, drafting of pleadings and discovery materials and trial and hearing preparation. Law clerks will also engage in case management on behalf of clients, and participate in community outreach and education.

QUALIFICATIONS: A demonstrated concern for the needs of Asian and Pacific Islander communities. A demonstrated concern for the needs of low-income people in general. Student must have completed at least one year of law school before starting the position. Bilingual skills in an Asian or Pacific Islander language highly desirable.

MINIMUM WEEKS REQUIRED: 10 weeks/full time (40 hours per week)

COMPENSATION: Qualified law students will be given a stipend for the summer.
